

April 12, 2021

The Rich Township Board met at the Township Hall. The meeting was called to order by Supervisor Scheuer at 7 pm. We recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

Members Present: Curell, Harvey, Mohr, Running, Scheuer. Members Absent: None.

Visitors: Mark Jaruzel, Bernie Milot, Jack & Joan Knowlton, Brandon Weaver, Ron Randall, Ron Gromak.

Motion by Harvey, supported by Curell to approve the agenda. MOTION CARRIED.

Motion by Curell, supported by Harvey to accept into record the minutes of the March meeting as drafted. MOTION CARRIED.

Motion by Scheuer, supported by Mohr to accept into record the Treasurers' Report as presented. MOTION CARRIED.

Motion by Scheuer, supported by Curell to pay the monthly bills as follows: from the General Fund, \$10,494.25 with checks numbered 13472 through 13487, from the Cemetery Fund \$19.09 with check number 1152, and from the Mosquito Fund \$15,500 with check number 1077. MOTION CARRIED.

There was discussion about finishing minor details on the pavilion. Many suggested waiting at least a year to paint the treated posts. We will leave them as they are for now. The door will be painted when weather permits.

Motion by Scheuer, supported by Curell to have Right Touch Landscaping finish up the grass area around the pavilion. MOTION CARRIED.

We discussed code enforcement issues, mainly marijuana and blight. We discussed appointing/hiring an individual to work exclusively in Rich Township on these issues. Scheuer and Bernie Milot will meet to discuss details and come up with a plan to present next month.

Scheuer will look into picnic tables for the pavilion.

We had previously thought that we may put porta-johns out near the pavilion, but due to the high cost, we will not be doing that.

Motion by Curell, supported by Mohr to approve paying Ron Gromak, or others, mileage when they are conducting township business. MOTION CARRIED. Individuals shall be responsible to inform clerk of their mileage.

Motion by Scheuer, supported by Curell to appoint Harvey to the County advisory council and to pay her mileage and per diem for attending these meetings. MOTION CARRIED.

Public comments/questions were received regarding: Binden Road bridge, is there anything in the ordinance about how many cats an individual can have on their property, Men of Faith thanked us for the use of the hall and submitted payment, a culvert on Rich Rd that needs attention – Scheuer will check it out, and, is there anything to prevent a semi from repeatedly travelling gravel roads.

Motion by Harvey, supported by Curell to adjourn. Meeting adjourned at 8:30 pm.
