

July 9, 2018

The Rich Township Board met at the Township Hall. The meeting was called to order by Supervisor Scheuer at 7:00 pm. We recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

Members Present: Curell, Harvey, Mohr, Running, Scheuer. Members Absent: None.

Visitors: Joan Fackler, Keith & Mariann Fleckenstein, Shari Emerick, Dennis Barefoot, Cheryl Clark, Mike and Cathy O'Grady.

Motion by Running supported by Curell to approve the agenda. MOTION CARRIED.

During brief public comment time, someone asked when the tax bills come in the mail as they had not received theirs yet. Curell informed them they just went out.

Cheryl Clark gave a brief report on what is going on at the county.

Joan Fackler, our township assessor spoke about her concerns with the proposed legislation, HB 6049 and SB 1025, regarding assessing reform and encouraged the board and all present to write legislators to express opposition to the bills.

Motion by Curell, supported by Harvey to accept into record the minutes of the June meeting with the following correction: Curell researched the cost of building a pavilion at the township hall and estimates it would cost \$6000 - \$6500. MOTION CARRIED.

Motion by Mohr, supported by Harvey to accept into record the Treasurers Report as presented and to pay the monthly bills: from the General Fund, \$9552.03 with checks numbered 12853 through 12864, from the Cemetery Fund, \$2620, with checks numbered 1095 through 1097, and from the Mosquito Fund, \$15,500 with check number 1062. MOTION CARRIED.

Scheuer gave an update on ordinance violations - there is a court date scheduled this month for the issue with Troy Patrick and unlicensed cars on Barnes Road.

Scheuer gave an update on the flagpole - a resident has offered to build a flagpole and donate it to the township.

There was some discussion about internet service at the hall. Curell is working on it. The telephone land line has been disconnected.

The July Board of Review meets on Wednesday, July 18 at 8:30 am at the township hall.

There will be a meeting of the Rich Township Election Commission immediately following the regular Board meeting for the purpose of appointing election inspectors to work at the Aug 7, 2018 Primary Election and setting their salaries.

There were no zoning permits issued since the last meeting.

Motion by Mohr, supported by Harvey to adjourn. Meeting adjourned at 8:20 pm.
