July 8, 2019

The Rich Township Board met at the Township Hall. The meeting was called to order by Supervisor Scheuer at 7:00 pm. We recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

Members Present: Curell, Harvey, Mohr, Running, Scheuer. Members Absent: None.

Visitors: Jack & Joan Knowlton, Garry Running, Dennis Barefoot, Keith & Mariann Fleckenstein.

Motion by Harvey, supported by Running to approve the agenda. MOTION CARRIED. For brief public comment, a question was asked which was on the agenda to be talked about when we get to that point.

Motion by Curell, supported by Harvey to accept into record the minutes of the June meeting as drafted. MOTION CARRIED.

Motion by Scheuer, supported by Running to accept into record the Treasurers Report as presented. MOTION CARRIED.

Motion by Mohr supported by Scheuer to pay the monthly bills as follows: from the General Fund, \$6051.09 with checks numbered 13074 through 13086, from the Cemetery Fund, \$1450.00, with check number 1116, and from the Mosquito Fund \$15,500.00 with check number 1068. MOTION CARRIED.

Scheuer gave a report on ordinance violations. Construction Code is in the process of getting the information required to issue a ticket for the tire violation on Barnes Road.

Motion by Curell, supported by Scheuer to do whatever is necessary to be able to store old records in the garage at the cemetery. MOTION CARRIED.

Motion by Curell, supported by Scheuer to contact Terry Jostock for a bid and have him get started on the roadside mowing. MOTION CARRIED.

There will be a Board of Review meeting on Wednesday, July 17 at 8:30 am at the township hall for the purpose of correcting qualified errors and to consider appeals related to various exemptions.

There was discussion about the Binden Road bridge. We have been concerned for some time about the condition and safety of this bridge and have contacted the Road Commission about it more than once. They have said it was sound. After the heavy rains of this spring and summer, it deteriorated further and has been closed. An article in the County Press of June 16 raises serious concerns about the cost to replace this bridge.

There were 2 zoning permits issued since the last meeting: 1. Aaron & Michele Winslow 1957 Castle Rd for a Solar Panel Array 2. Mimi & Anthony Slanga 49 Elmwood Rd for a preassembled Amish barn (on skids).

There was one item of correspondence about the annual testing of the water at the township hall. A sample was drawn today for retesting, results expected by the end of the week.

Motion by Mohr, supported by Curell to adjourn. Meeting adjourned at 8 pm.
