Motion by Curell, supported by Running to approve the agenda. MOTION CARRIED.

Motion by Curell, supported by Scheuer to accept into record the minutes of the May meeting as drafted. MOTION CARRIED.

Motion by Scheuer, supported by Harvey to accept into record the Treasurers' Report as presented. MOTION CARRIED.

Motion by Curell, supported by Scheuer to pay the monthly bills as follows: from the General Fund, \$15,648.44 with checks numbered 13270 through 13291, from the Cemetery Fund, \$1529.00 with checks numbered 1131 and 1132, and from the Mosquito Fund, \$15,500.00 with check number 1073. Scheuer gave an update on road grading and brining.

Discussion on pavilion. Motion by Harvey, supported by Curell to have Scheuer get bids for the pavilion in the yard at the township hall. MOTION CARRIED. We will look at the bids at July meeting.

NEW BUSINESS:

The Binden Road bridge is closed.

Our assessor has resigned effective July 27. There was discussion about a new assessor. Several names were discussed. Curell will or has talked to equalization departments in Lapeer and Tuscola counties for their recommendations.

There was one zoning permit issued since the last meeting: David Wilkie 7124 Nelson Lane for a Single Family / with Attached Garage 2286 Sq Ft Ranch.

There was one item of correspondence discussed. Clerk received an email from AirAdvantage letting us know that they were unsuccessful in their efforts to secure grant money from the State for the purpose of improving broadband services in our area.

During public comment time, a resident let us know about an internet service he found that he has been using for working at home that is working out quite well for him. Several were interested. It is AT&T Fixed Wireless.
