

March 12, 2018

The Rich Township Board met at the Township Hall. The meeting was called to order by Supervisor Scheuer at 7:00 pm. We recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

Members Present: Curell, Harvey, Mohr, Running, Scheuer. Members Absent: None.

Visitors: Joan Knowlton, Ron Randall, Mark Monson, Ali Suede, Tricia Kester with Sloane & Selah, Garry Running, Brandon Miller, Gary Glenn entered at 7:30.

Motion by Curell, supported by Harvey to approve the agenda. MOTION CARRIED.

Brandon Miller is going to run for election to the County Commission and addressed the Board and visitors about his reasons for such.

Motion by Curell, supported by Harvey to accept into record the minutes of the February meeting as drafted. MOTION CARRIED.

Motion by Mohr, supported by Scheuer to accept into record the Treasurers Report as presented and to pay the monthly bills: from the General Fund, \$14,429.71 with checks numbered 12771 through 12799, and from the Cemetery Fund, \$638.82 with checks numbered 1090 and 1091. MOTION CARRIED.

Supervisor Scheuer gave an update on various ordinance violations. McIntyre Rd owner was present for discussion, Barnes Rd owners are saying they will comply, Silverwood Rd dangerous building is still a problem as the work has not been completed. Neighbor was present asking for help to get this situation taken care of.

Scheuer is working with Dennis at the Road Commission to decide what road projects to work on this year. Extra ditching work may be considered. Barnes Road bridge/culvert east of 24 is on the state schedule for repair in 2020. It was discussed that balancing tubes are what is needed for Barnes Road west of 24 to take care of the water problem that occurs with heavy rain.

Motion by Curell, supported by Scheuer to allow the builder who is working on the kitchen remodel project to investigate the present support system on the wall where the pass - thru windows are located and proceed at his discretion not to exceed an additional \$800. MOTION CARRIED.

Motion by Running, supported by Harvey to approve the treasurer and supervisor to attend the wind turbine meeting in October 2017, and the Pipeline Safety Meeting in February 2018. MOTION CARRIED.

Motion by Running, supported by Harvey to approve \$50 per diem for appointed or elected township personnel to attend township business related meetings that have been approved by the Township Board and for which an expense voucher is required to be submitted to the clerk. MOTION CARRIED.

The Rich Township Board of Review meets tomorrow, Tuesday, March 13 from 3 until 9 pm and Wednesday, March 14 from 9 am until 3 pm.

We held our Budget Public Hearing. Motion by Curell, supported by Scheuer to approve the Budget for fiscal year 2018-2019 as presented. MOTION CARRIED.

Motion by Curell, supported by Running to approve the Audit contract with King & King for the 2017-2018 fiscal year. MOTION CARRIED.

Motion by Curell, supported by Scheuer to amend the cemetery budget in the following amounts: \$40 for Mowing and \$4500 for Grave Opening Expense. MOTION CARRIED.

There were no zoning permits issued since the last meeting.

Mr Suede spoke about the ordinance violation at his property on McIntyre Road. He agreed to have the site in compliance by June 11, 2018.

Resident who owns property on Kelch Road spoke about the farm near his property and his opinion that it would be hard to sell the property or build on it. He also talked about a driveway that was put in without a culvert and backs up water on his property, and stated the ditches need to be brushed and cleaned out.

Gary Glenn spoke briefly. He is running for the Republican nomination for the State Senate seat in our district in August.

Resident on Millington Road asked about the ditch in front of her house.

Curell gave us information about bank accounts that some funds will be transferred to for reasons of better interest.

Motion by Harvey, supported by Curell to adjourn. Meeting adjourned at 8:40 pm.
