The Rich Township Board met at the Township Hall. The meeting was called to order at 6 pm. We recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

Members Present: Chittick-Harvey, Curell, Mohr, Running, Scheuer. Members Absent: None.

Visitors: Bob Gilling, Mark Jaruzel, Ben Seago from APM, Ron Gromak, Dan Hurd. Motion by Curell, supported by Running to approve the agenda. MOTION CARRIED.

Motion by Curell, supported by Scheuer to accept into record the minutes of the October meeting as drafted. MOTION CARRIED.

Motion by Scheuer, supported by Running to accept into record the Treasurers' Report as presented. MOTION CARRIED.

Motion by Scheuer, supported by Mohr, to pay monthly bills from the General Fund, \$106,890.07 with checks numbered13843 through 13859. MOTION CARRIED.

Motion by Scheuer, supported by Curell to pay monthly bills from the Cemetery Fund, \$1552.50 with checks numbered 1192 and 1193. MOTION CARRIED.

Ben Seago from APM gave a report on the mosquito control season and let us know that the contract will go up for next year.

There was discussion about the Binden Road bridge. The work is going on now.

Bob Gilling and Ron Gromak spoke about Gillings' property that was enrolled in the PA 116 program many years ago, but previous owner did not use the program benefits. Gilling is seeking approval from township board to remove the land from the program and assured us it will remain farmland. Motion by Curell, supported by Scheuer to approve the application by Mr. Gilling to remove his property from the PA 116 Farmland Preservation Program. MOTION CARRIED.

Rich Township Board of Review will meet in December, if necessary, date unknown at the present time. Date will be provided by assessor.

There were no zoning permits issued since the last meeting.

During public comment time, Mark Jaruzel spoke for several minutes about his concerns over election issues. He asked the clerk to consider hand counting ballots from the November election. Clerk will look into it to see if it is permissible under current law.

Motion by Curell, supported by Chittick-Harvey to adjourn. Meeting adjourned at 7:19 pm.
