The Rich Township Board met at the Township Hall. The meeting was called to order by Supervisor Scheuer at 7:00 pm. We recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

Members Present: Curell, Mohr, Running, Scheuer. Members Absent: Harvey.

Motion by Curell supported by Mohr to approve the agenda. MOTION CARRIED.

Motion by Curell, supported by Mohr to accept into record the minutes of the September meeting as drafted. MOTION CARRIED.

Motion by Running, supported by Scheuer to accept into record the Treasurers Report as presented. MOTION CARRIED.

Motion by Mohr, supported by Scheuer to pay the monthly bills: from the General Fund, \$102,652.59 with checks numbered 12920 through 12933, and from the Cemetery Fund, \$1734.70, with checks numbered 1101 & 1102. MOTION CARRIED.

Unfinished Business:

Scheuer gave a brief report on ordinance violations, there is nothing major going on right now.

Curell is still looking into the best option for internet at the hall.

New Business:

Discussion about getting a new township attorney has been tabled until next month.

Still waiting on the individual who has offered to build a new flag pole for the hall.

There will be an Election Commission Meeting immediately following the regular board meeting tonight.

The Zoning Ordinance Amendment for Wind Energy has been sent to the County for their review. Planning Commission Chair Ron Gromak commended Darlene Lott and Dennis Barefoot for their extra work on the Amendment.

Motion by Scheuer, supported by Curell to add 2 fire runs to the tax roll: a structure fire at 1800 Murphy Lake Road, and a brush or barn fire at 9825 Kelch Road. MOTION CARRIED.

There were 2 zoning permits issued since the last meeting: to Michael & Jackie Merser 8701 Rich Road for a 30 x 32 garage and to Steve & Adrian Shisslett 1796 Murphy Lake Road for an Addition, Garage Living Quarters.

During public comment time, Mark Jaruzel thanked the Planning Commission for all their hard work on the wind energy amendment.

Motion by Curell, supported by Mohr to adjourn. Meeting adjourned at 8:05 pm.
