

July 9, 2012

The Rich Township Board met at the Township Hall. The meeting was called to order by Supervisor Henne at 7 pm. We recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

Members present: Curell, Henne, Mohr, Running. Members absent: Mathews.

Visitors: Jim & Arlene Sullivan, Ralph Gilpin, Melissa Malcolm, Pat Wright, Kelli Lovasz, Jill Fox, Karen Curell, Dyle Henning, Pete Church and Tom Harmon.

Motion by Curell, supported by Mohr to accept into record the minutes of the June meeting as presented. MOTION CARRIED.

Motion by Mohr, supported by Henne to accept into record the Treasurers Report as presented and to pay the monthly bills: from the General Fund, \$3265.77 with checks numbered 11605 through 11614, from the Cemetery Fund, \$1185.00 with check number 974 and from the Mosquito Account, \$14,000.00 with check number 1026. MOTION CARRIED.

The director of the Lapeer District Library, Melissa Malcolm, spoke in answer to our board's concern about why none of Rich Township's tax money goes to the Mayville Library when such a large portion of our township residents live close to and use the Mayville Library. Ms. Malcolm gave us a copy of a writing from herself to the Lapeer District Library Board and dated April 2012, in which she recommends library representatives meet to discuss the distribution of revenues from Arcadia, Deerfield and Rich townships. This document is on file in the clerk's office.

We received an update on the roadside mowing. It is approximately 25% done and expected to be completed by this Friday.

Henne read a letter from Tom Harmon outlining his plans for the property on Kelch Road that has been in violation of our zoning ordinance. Mr. Harmon suggested a meeting at the property with Henne and Edwards on August 1<sup>st</sup>.

The township audit has been completed.

The public accuracy test for the August election will be held tomorrow, July 10<sup>th</sup> at 4 pm.

The July Board of Review meeting will be held on July 17 at 9 am.

There were no zoning permits issued since the last meeting.

Discussion about the Supervisors' and Treasurers' cell phones and about whether to continue returning the unused portion of a Board of Appeals or Special Land Use application fee was tabled until the August meeting.

Motion by Curell, supported by Mohr to adjourn. MOTION CARRIED. Meeting adjourned at 8:17 pm.
