

TOWNSHIP OF RICH
RESOLUTION FOR MOSQUITO CONTROL MILLAGE PROPOSAL

At a meeting of the Rich Township Board held on the 17th day of April, 2024, this Resolution was offered by Curell and supported by Chittick-Harvey.

WHEREAS, the prior millage for mosquito control purposes within Rich Township approved in 2020 will expire at the end of this year; and

WHEREAS, the Township Board desires to submit to the electors of the Township the question of levying millage to renew the expiring mosquito control millage;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

1. The Township Board hereby directs that a millage proposal be submitted to the electors of Rich Township on the question of levying two (2) mills for 4 years for mosquito control purposes within the Township at the election to be held on the 8th day of August, 2024.
2. The ballot proposal shall be worded as follows:

**PROPOSAL FOR RENEWAL OF
EXPIRED MOSQUITO CONTROL MILLAGE FOR RICH TOWNSHIP**

Shall the expiring previous voted increase in the tax limitation imposed under Article IX, Section 6, of the Michigan Constitution of two (2) mills (\$2.00 per \$1000.00 of taxable value) on general ad valorem property within Rich Township be renewed at the previously voted 2.000 mills (\$2.00 per \$ 1,000 of taxable value) for a period of four (4) years, 2025 through 2028 inclusive, for the purpose of reducing and controlling the mosquito population within the Township; and shall the Township levy such millage for said purpose, thereby raising in the first year an estimated \$104,463?
