

**TOWNSHIP OF RICH
RESOLUTION FOR ROAD MILLAGE PROPOSAL**

At a meeting of the Rich Township Board held on the 17th day of April, 2024, this Resolution was offered by Kester and supported by Curell .

WHEREAS, the prior millage for road and bridge purposes within Rich Township approved in 2020 will expire at the end of this year; and

WHEREAS, the Township Board desires to submit to the electors of the Township the question of levying millage to renew the expiring road and bridge millage;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

1. The Township Board hereby directs that a millage proposal be submitted to the electors of Rich Township on the question of levying one (1) mill for 4 years for road and bridge purposes within the Township at the election to be held on the 6th day of August, 2024.
2. The ballot proposal shall be worded as follows:

**PROPOSAL FOR RENEWAL OF
EXPIRED ROAD MILLAGE FOR RICH TOWNSHIP**

Shall the expiring previous voted increase in the tax limitation imposed under Article IX, Section 6, of the Michigan Constitution of one (1) mill (\$1.00 per \$1000.00 of taxable value) on general ad valorem property within Rich Township be renewed at the previously voted 1.000 mill (\$1.00 per \$ 1,000 of taxable value) for a period of (4) years, 2025 through 2028 inclusive, for road and bridge construction and maintenance purposes within the Township; and shall the Township levy such millage for said purpose, thereby raising in the first year an estimated \$52,231?
